Wednesday, June 10, 2009	June monthly activities report (all lobbyists filing monthly)	May 1, 2009, <i>or</i> January 1, 2009, if first activities report*	May 31, 2009

* If you file your initial lobby registration after January 1, 2009, your first activities report must cover the reporting period beginning January 1 and ending on the last day of the month in which you register (or ending on December 31 if you file annually). For example, if a registrant first registers on June 4, 2009, that registrant's first monthly report (due by July 10, 2009) would cover the period beginning January 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2009.

If you are ever confused about the beginning date for a required report, remember this rule for reporting: **There should never be gaps between reporting periods and there should never be overlaps.**
